Abstract

What is the research subject that you wish to address?

The Living Peace intervention (LPint) in Eastern DRC works with men who are perceived as violent by their communities. Through a 16-session, 16-week group therapeutic intervention where participants sit together in groups of 15 men, the men work around the concept of Positive Masculinity to reduce Gender Based Violence (GBV).
